Two Payment Plan:

Students may elect the Two Payment Plan for each semester, whereby one half of the balance plus a \$50 fee is due by August 1st. The remaining balance is due by the final payment due date listed above.

- If payment is not received by the payment due date, registration is subject to cancellation.
- If you are receiving any financial or tuition assistance, confirmed verification with payment must accompany your registration.
- If you are registering for a course that requires an additional course fee, you will be billed accordingly.
- Any student withdrawing prior to the first day of classes will receive a credit for all tuition, less the mandatory non-refundable registration fee.

Dropping a course - Any student dropping prior to the first day of classes will receive a credit for all tuition, less the mandatory non-refundable registration fee. Non-attendance in a course and/or non-payment for a course does not constitute an official drop. Students will be responsible for payment of all tuition & fees until an official withdrawal is presented to Academic Services. Refunds are calculated according to the refund schedule printed below as of the date the drop is received.

Refund Schedule:

100% credit of tuition if droppedprior to August 29, 2009
90% credit of tuition if droppedprior to September 5, 2009
50% credit of tuition if dropped prior to September 19, 2009
25% credit of tuition if droppedprior to September 26, 2009
Thereafter - no refund.

Courses taken at Garden City - Students who take any courses held at the Garden City campus, will be governed by the on-campus tuition and fee policy of \$780 per credit (\$795 for upper division) plus Garden City fees for part-time study (1 – 11 credits) and \$11,610 flat-rate (for students enrolled prior to 07-08), \$12,050 flat-rate (for students entered 07-08), \$12,515 flat-rate (for students entering 08-09 or later), (\$12,650 for upper division) plus Garden City fees for full-time study (12 or more credits).
