Abstract: This collection consists of 69 letters (and two envelopes without letters) written

between 1943 and 1945 by Sgt. Harry Koehler to his parents living in East Hempstead, New York while serving in the US military during WWII.

Biographical History

Harry Koehler was born on March 19, 1922 in Nesconset, New York to George and Catherine Koehler (née Weber). He had 6 brothers (his first born brother George died at the age of 5). He entered the US Army Air Corps on October 24, 1942 (having enlisted on October 15, 1942 in New York City) and served during World War II as a Sergeant with the 674th Bombardment Squadron, 417 Bombardment Group which operated in the Southwest Pacific Theater of Operations during the Philippines and New Guinea campaigns. The 417th Bombardment Group was activated on March 28, 1943 and inactivated on November 15, 1945. Harry Koehler died on October 7, 1993 and is buried at Calverton National Cemetery in Calverton, New York.

Scope and Content of the Collection

This collection consists of 69 letters (and two envelopes without letters) written between 1943 and 1945 by Sgt. Harry Koehler to his parents living in East Hempstead, New York while serving in the US military during WWII. Sgt. Koehler served with the 674th Bombardment Squadron, 417 Bombardment Group which operated in the Southwest Pacific Theater of Operations during the Philippines and New Guinea campaigns. The 417th Bombardment Group was activated on March 28, 1943 and inactivated on November 15, 1945. Sgt. Koehler sent the letters from many locales including Chanute Air Force Base in Illinois, Amarillo Texas, the Philippines, the Dutch East Indies, and Okinawa, Japan.
