**Financial Aid:**

- The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is available starting October 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 for the 2017-2018 academic year on [www.FAFSA.GOV](http://www.FAFSA.GOV). Our FAFSA Adelphi school code is 002666. Priority filing dates can be found on our website [www.financial-aid.adelphi.edu](http://www.financial-aid.adelphi.edu).
- Undergraduate students who are New York State residents are suggested to file a NYS TAP Grant application. Our school code is 0010.

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- Undergraduate students are considered for Federal Unsubsidized/Subsidized Direct Loans (3.76% interest rate). In reviewing your FAFSA application, eligibility is also determined for Federal Grants (Pell) and University need-based grants.
- You must maintain a minimum of six (6) credits per semester in order to maintain eligibility for Federal Direct Loans
- Financial Aid does not directly cover the summer semester (if coursework is required). If you do have to take summer sessions, you are suggested to reach out to the Office of Student Services or Student Financial Services for information about summer financial aid.

**Scholarships:**

- All academic merit-based scholarships are awarded through the Office of Admissions upon acceptance to the University. If you meet the criteria for a University scholarship, an award letter will be provided to you. You may also speak with the respective academic departments for scholarship information.

### Dropping a course –

Any student dropping prior to the first day of classes will receive a credit for all tuition, less the mandatory non-refundable registration fee. Non-attendance in a course and/or non-payment for a course does not constitute an official drop. Students will be responsible for payment of all tuition & fees until an official withdrawal form is presented to Academic Services. Refunds are calculated according to the refund schedule printed below as of the date the drop is received.
