Two Payment Plan:

Students may elect the Two Payment Plan for each semester, whereby one half of the balance plus a \$60 fee is due by August 1. The remaining balance is due by the final payment due date listed above.

- If payment is not received by the payment due date, registration is subject to cancellation.
- If you are receiving any financial or tuition assistance, confirmed verification with payment must accompany your registration.
- If you are registering for a course that requires an additional course fee, you will be billed accordingly.
- Any student withdrawing prior to the first day of classes will receive a credit for all tuition, less the mandatory non-refundable registration fee.

Dropping a course- Any student dropping prior to the first day of classes will receive a credit for all tuition, less the mandatory non-refundable registration fee. Non-attendance in a course and/or non-payment for a course does not constitute an official drop. Students will be responsible for payment of all tuition & fees until an official withdrawal form is presented to Academic Services. Refunds are calculated according to the refund schedule printed below as of the date the drop is received.

Refund Schedule:

100% credit of tuition if dropped.....	prior to August 29
90% credit of tuition if dropped	prior to September 5
50% credit of tuition if dropped	prior to September 19
25% credit of tuition if dropped	prior to September 26 2016

Courses taken at Garden City - Students who take any courses held at the Garden City campus, will be governed by the on-campus tuition and fee policy of \$1040 per credit (\$1,065 for upper division) plus Garden City fees for part-time study (1 – 11 credits) and \$17,000 flat-rate plus Garden City fees for full-time study (12 – 17 credits).
