Terms and Conditions

This document constitutes an agreement between the undersigned student-resident and/or the parent or guardian of such student-resident if the student-resident is under 18 years of age (hereinafter collectively called "resident") and Adelphi University (hereinafter called "University"). This agreement sets forth the terms and conditions pertaining to the occupancy of a residence hall at Adelphi University. In addition you are agreeing to the terms, conditions, and policies contained in the Code of Conduct, as well as other publications such as the Undergraduate Bulletin, the Graduate Bulletin, the Room Inventory and Condition Record, the Guide to Student Life, the 2017 Pre-College Summer Program Student Handbook and the Directory of Classes.

No guarantee is made concerning the number of occupants in a room. If a vacancy occurs in a room, the remaining student(s) in that room will accept a new occupant or be relocated (consolidated) to another room with or without a roommate. Failure to comply may result in termination of the agreement.

Insurance (personal property)

- 1. The University assumes no liability for loss of or damage to the resident's property. Residents should secure adequate coverage either through their parents' or guardians' homeowner's insurance, or through additional insurance.

Room Assignments

- 2. The Pre-College Program will cross list program student participants. The University reserves the right to make room assignments or room changes at its discretion. This agreement does not guarantee a specific room. No student-resident will be denied a room assignment based on race, color, religion, sex, sexual preference, age, national/ethnic origin, physical disability, or status as a disabled or Vietnam-era veteran.

Cancellation/Termination of the Agreement by the University

- 3. The University may terminate its agreement with the student at any time in the event of a resident's violation of the University's policies governing student conduct, residence hall regulations, non-payment, health, safety, or behavioral reasons.

I understand that my signature obligates me financially for the cost of a residence hall space from the date of sign-in/occupancy through the end of the session. By signing this agreement, I understand that my assignment may be changed to accommodate scheduled maintenance.
