Students selected for this Sport-Based Youth Development Fellowship will earn a Master's degree from Adelphi University in Physical Education or Sport Management in two years, with all tuition costs covered (18 credits a year). SBYD Fellows will specialize in Sport-Based Youth Development as part of their Master's degree. Students will work part-time for one of three organizations as part of the SBYD Fellowship, gaining valuable experience in the field of sport-based youth development.

A: SBYD Fellows will work part-time at one of these three organizations:



Wellness in the Schools inspires healthy eating, environmental awareness and fitness as a way of life for kids in public schools. Through meaningful public/private partnerships with school leadership, teachers, chefs, coaches, parents and kids, WITS develops and implements programs that provide healthy foods, healthy environments and opportunities for regular play to help kids learn and grow.



Kids in the Game provides opportunities to NYC's youth through sports, movement, and play. From school programs (recess, physical education, afterschool) to day camps and sports clinics, their programs emphasize developing fundamental skills, leadership qualities, and healthy habits.



New Amsterdam Fencing Academy provides a comprehensive training program in fencing. From recreational fencers to national competitors, from pre-schoolers with foam swords to teens on high-school teams, the focus is on learning, growth, fitness, confidence, and mastery.

Q: When will I work?

A: SBYD Fellows will work during the K-12 school year at NYC schools, along with some SBYD Fellows working during the summer (if required by the organization). During the school year, graduate classes are in the evening.
