Terms and Conditions STEM Scholars Program

- 1. Your award of a STEM Scholars Scholarship for the Fall and Spring semesters of the 2024-2025 academic year and subsequent years is made based on your fulfillment of the following requirements:
 - a. Enroll in full-time study at Adelphi University with a minimum of twelve (12) credits per semester, pursuing a bachelor's degree in one of the following majors: biology, biochemistry, chemistry, computer science, environmental science, mathematics, or physics. Changing majors outside of this list will result in loss of this scholarship. If you need to drop to part-time, contact the program director, Dr. Ward, to discuss the impacts to the scholarship;
 - Successfully complete a minimum of 18 credits per academic year in your program of study (be cautious, failures and withdrawals may affect successful completion);
 - c. Maintain Pell-eligibility for each year of the award.
- 2. Students that drop below a **2.5** cumulative GPA may be put on probation for the STEM Scholars program. Students who stay below a **2.5** cumulative GPA for 2 semesters may be removed from the program.
- 3. Students are highly encouraged to participate in academic and social support associated with the program.
- 4. The University reserves the right to revoke this award based on academic or behavioral violations.
- 5. All scholarship recipients must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) annually with the U.S. Department of Education regardless of expected eligibility for financial assistance. You will receive a financial assistance award notification from the One-Stop Student Services Center after you file the FAFSA. At that time you will also be informed of all instructions that may apply to your scholarship or other financial assistance. This award may be readjusted once your eligibility for federal, state, and other institutional aid has been determined.
- 6. The amount of the award will be the unmet need for the student as determined by One Stop. The maximum annual award is \$15,000. The maximum total award over 4 years is \$60,000.
- 7. The combined scholarships may not exceed the cost of attendance at Adelphi University. The university reserves the right to adjust the financial assistance previously awarded when these awards in combination with other resources exceed the cost of attendance, including but not limited to Veterans educational benefits, external awards, and federal and state scholarships and grants. Students enrolled in contractual programs with discounted tuition may be ineligible to receive Adelphi scholarships and grants.
