Methodology

The Center for Career and Professional Development at Adelphi University annually surveys graduating students to ascertain their employment status or plans for continuing education, as well as to acquire insights into hiring trends. Our survey aligns with the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) First Destination Survey to track the progress of new college graduates as they enter the job market.

Graduate outcomes and salary data results are based on data collected up to 1-year post graduation from the Graduate Outcomes Survey, self-reported information, LinkedIn, National Clearinghouse, and online research of salary ranges associated with related job titles/descriptions.

Each graduating class is made up of students who graduate from July 1 through June 30; thus, the Class of 2022 is composed of students who graduated from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. This report examines the career outcomes of **1,382 Undergraduates** who earned their Adelphi degree in August 2021, December 2021, or May 2022. Students were surveyed just prior to and up to six months after graduation, during three survey administration periods: August 2021-February 2022, December 2021-June 2022, and May 2022-November 2022. This is consistent with the definition used by the U.S. Department of Education in gathering education statistics for its IPEDS database.

The Career Outcomes Rate for the academic year 2021-2022, that includes cohorts August '21, December '21 or January '22, and May'22 is **91.19%.** We also follow NACE protocols to determine the Knowledge Rate** which is **64.03**% for the Class of 2022.





Knowledge Rate



Note: The term "Career Outcomes Rate" is the percentage of graduates who have reported being engaged in a career outcome. This percentage is calculated by determining the number of respondents employed full or part-time, continuing their education, volunteer service or military service, and dividing that total by the number of students about whom we have information. The term "Knowledge Rate" is the percentage of graduates for which we have reasonable, verifiable information concerning graduates' post-graduation career plans. Data can be collected from sources including graduation surveys, online surveys, telephone and email solicitations, alumni records, social media research, and input from faculty, staff, and employers.



Career Outcomes Rate




89.10% of Adelphi graduates in the Class of 2022 reported that they were either Working or Continuing Education, 7.50% were still looking for employment, 0.40% were enrolled in Volunteering, 0.50% were enrolled in Fellowship/post-doc/traineeship/post-graduation internship and 2.40% were not planning to work at the moment.

Annual Salary for August 2021 & May 2022




The Overall Average Annual Salary is **\$80,090** for students graduating between August 2021 to May 2022.



74.90% of Class of 2021 respondents reported receiving job offers prior to graduation, 18.8% of the graduates received offers within 0-3 months after graduation, and 6.3% of graduates received offers after 6 months of graduation.

3. Employment Data b. Hiring by Industry




The greatest percentage of new graduates reported obtaining employment in the fields of Education, Finance, Banking, and Healthcare.





Success Data I: Intellectual curiosity




92.0% of Graduates **Strongly Agree** that graduating from Adelphi University increased his or her intellectual ability and potential as a curious, successful person.

Success Data II: Understanding of profession




90.20% of Graduates **Strongly Agree** that graduating from Adelphi University increased their understanding related to the roles of professionals in their field.
