EMPLOYMENT FOLLOW UP SURVEY INITIAL PROGRAMS 2020-2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

A follow-up survey was electronically distributed to the 185 graduates in October-November 2021, who met either of the following: 1) did not complete the Exit Survey 2) did not have employment at the time of May 2021. The aim was to track employment statuses 5-6 months post-graduation. **27 out of 185 graduates completed the Employment Follow-up Survey for a response rate of 15%.**

The first question asked graduates if they are presently employed in the education field.
