EMPLOYMENT FOLLOW-UP SURVEY INITIAL PROGRAMS 2022-2023 ACADEMIC YEAR

A follow-up survey was electronically distributed to the 172 graduates in October-November 2023, who met either of the following criteria: 1) did not complete the Exit Survey 2) did not have employment at the time of May 2023. The aim was to track employment statuses 5-6 months post-graduation. **Thirty out of 172 graduates completed the Employment Follow-up Survey for a response rate of 17%.**

The first question asked graduates if they are presently employed in the education field.
