## INITIAL PROGRAMS 2023-2024 ACADEMIC YEAR

A follow-up survey was electronically distributed to the 172 graduates in October-November 2024, who met either of the following criteria: 1) did not complete the Exit Survey 2) did not have employment at the time of May 2024. The aim was to track employment statuses 5-6 months post-graduation. **Twenty two of 163 graduates completed the Employment Follow-up Survey for a response rate of 13%.** 

The first question asked graduates if they are presently employed in the education field.
