Notes from the April 7, 2017 Meeting

1. The committee watched the "Authentic Voices" video shared by John.
 - a. There is a need to address the short term vs long term needs related to the Task Force's multimedia efforts.
 - b. We should not "give-up" on video but make sure we are taking necessary steps to make sure any videos released are fully endorsed and signed off on by the student(s) showcased.
 - c. A StoryCorps + Inclusion Has No Borders inspired "deign intervention" is worth pursuing.
 - d. Group discussed concern over exposing students.
2. Gene Palma reported on his and Dr. Riordan's meeting with officials from the GC and Nassau County Police Depts.
 - a. Local law enforcement will not participate in any round ups. Will not target heavy immigrant communities or ask for status.
 - b. GC Police is willing to participate at any Town Hall meetings in GC.
 - c. Agreed that no policies will be changed without talking to community.
 - d. Consensus that Adelphi will not provide with any information until legal warrants are presented.
 - However, an ICE warrant is not necessary with a criminal record or offense.
 - Includes all campus hubs.
 - e. The group discussed ways to communicate with the rest of the campus about protocols.
 - Article in Delphian, speak to Directors across campus to spread to appropriate areas.
3. What do we do now? How do we provide a safe place?
 - a. Wendy's office get 3 to 4 calls a day on concerns about traveling.
 - b. Wendy will send a survey out to students to gather information/stats on students concerns of travel during the summer break.
 - c. Emergency Housing sub committee will meet on 4/11 and report back criteria and how to implement.
