As a student in the Learning Resource Program, you'll:

- Receive concentrated, individualized attention from a learning specialist.
- Build academic, writing, time-management and organizational skills.
- Receive help with course and career planning.
- Have the option to participate in on-site executive function coaching and mental health counseling services.
- Gain important self-advocacy skills.

Please note that there is an additional fee associated with the Learning Resource Program. For the 2025–2026 academic year, this fee amounts to \$5,645 per semester.

Get a Jump Start With Our Summer Pre-College Program

Students enrolled at Adelphi and the Learning Resource Program can kick-start their fall college experience by participating in Adelphi's Summer Pre-College Program. During the three-week program, students:

- Complete a 3-credit course taught by Adelphi professors.
- Participate in small group academic workshops to enhance important college skills.
- Meet regularly with an assigned learning specialist for individualized academic support.
- Become familiar with the resources available at Adelphi and within the program (like separate quiet study rooms).

How to apply

You can apply to Adelphi University through the Adelphi application or the Common application at adelphi.edu/apply. When you apply, just check “Learning Resource Program” under the “Signature Programs” section if you’re interested in joining.

After you submit your Adelphi application, you’ll have the option to share any documents (like IEPs or 504 plans) that might help the Learning Resource Program better support your success.

The Learning Resource Program is an opt-in program. That means once you’re accepted to Adelphi, you can choose to join by submitting the additional LRP deposit when you secure your spot at the University.
