1. To be eligible for the Adelphi Alumni Award for Graduate Study for the 2026-2027 academic year and beyond, you must meet the requirements listed below. Please note, this award is applicable to your Summer, Fall, and Spring semesters of study.
 2. You must have completed a bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degree at Adelphi University, be accepted into a new graduate program, and enroll as a new Adelphi graduate student for a minimum of 6 credits **per semester** on or after summer 2025.
 - Enroll in **6–8 credits per semester** to receive \$1,000 per semester.
 - Enroll in **9 or more credits per semester** to receive \$2,500 per semester.
 - This award is applicable for study at the Garden City campus or our centers in Hauppauge, Manhattan, or Hudson Valley.
 3. The amount of your award is determined by your credit enrollment each semester as outlined above. **This award, in combination with all other tuition-specific awards, cannot exceed the cost of tuition and fees.**
 4. This award is not applicable to students enrolled in contractual programs, graduate online programs, or those who receive other forms of Adelphi University scholarships, grants, or remissions.
 5. You must notify Adelphi's One-Stop Student Services Center of any additional scholarship or award you receive. Your award may be adjusted to ensure compliance with all institutional, federal, and state regulations, and to ensure total aid does not exceed tuition and fee costs.
 6. While not required for this award, it is advised to annually file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) with the U.S. Department of Education. After filing, eligible students will receive a College Financing Plan (CFP) outlining costs and aid.
 7. Academic scholarships for fifth-year students in the Scholar Teacher Education Program (STEP) and undergraduate-to-graduate business pathway programs (3+1 or 4+1 options)—**excluding the Flex Business Administration MBA program**—and other University tuition remission programs cannot be used in conjunction with this award.
 8. Adelphi University reserves the right to revoke or adjust this award based on academic or behavioral violations, changes in enrollment, or eligibility for other federal, state, or institutional aid.
