1. To be eligible for the Adelphi Graduate Merit Scholarship beginning in the summer 2026, fall 2026, and spring 2027 semesters, you must meet the requirements listed below.
    - You must be **fully admitted into an eligible graduate program** and enroll as a new Adelphi graduate student.
    - You may choose to take **6–8 credits per semester** or enroll in **9 or more credits per semester** at the Garden City campus, our centers in Hauppauge, Manhattan, Hudson Valley, or select online programs.
  2. This award will be disbursed throughout the course of your graduate study. Each semester's award amount will be based on your enrollment status on a prorated basis each semester, based upon your full-time (minimum of 9 credits per semester) or part-time (6-8 credits per semester) enrollment status. **The level of your award each semester will depend on your actual enrollment.**
  3. This award, in combination with other tuition awards, cannot exceed the costs for tuition and fees. This award may not be combined with any other forms of scholarships, grants, or remission. If the amount of this scholarship exceeds any other form of institutional aid, it will replace any award of a lower amount.
  4. You will automatically be considered upon receipt of your complete graduate admissions application. Eligible students will receive a scholarship letter with their letter of acceptance. Recipients who have filed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) and are eligible for federal financial aid will also receive a College Financing Plan stating the amount of the award.
  5. Adelphi University reserves the right to revoke or adjust this award based on academic or behavioral violations, changes in enrollment, or eligibility for other federal, state, or institutional aid.
