1. To be eligible for the Adelphi Graduate Social Work Scholarship beginning in the fall of 2026 or spring of 2027, you must meet the requirements listed below.
 2. You must be fully admitted into an eligible graduate program and enroll as a new Adelphi graduate student.
 - Enroll in **6–8 credits per semester** for an award of up to \$2,222 per semester.
 - Enroll in **9 or more credits per semester** for an award of up to \$5,000 per semester.
 - This award is applicable for study at the Garden City campus or our centers in Hauppauge, NYC-Brooklyn, or Hudson Valley.
 3. The level of your award each semester will depend on your actual enrollment. Each admitted MSW student is reviewed holistically for consideration of a scholarship of up to \$20,000.
 4. This award may be applied toward the following programs: **On-campus MSW in Social Work** and **Advanced Standing MSW** programs.
 5. This award, in combination with other tuition awards, cannot exceed the costs for tuition and fees. This award may not be combined with any other forms of scholarships, grants, or remission. If the amount of this scholarship exceeds any other form of institutional aid, it will replace any award of a lower amount.
 6. You will automatically be considered upon receipt of your complete graduate admissions application. Eligible students will receive a scholarship letter with their letter of acceptance.
 7. Students are encouraged to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) as soon as possible, but no later than the priority deadline. Recipients who have filed the FAFSA® and are eligible for federal financial aid will also receive a College Financing Plan stating the amount of the award.
 8. Adelphi University reserves the right to revoke or adjust this award based on academic or behavioral violations, changes in enrollment, or eligibility for other federal, state, or institutional aid.
