

1. To be eligible for the Adelphi University PhD in Nursing Award for the 2026–2027 academic year and beyond, you must meet the requirements listed below. Please note that this award is applicable to your Fall and Spring semesters of study.
2. You must be admitted into an eligible PhD in Nursing program at Adelphi University and enroll as a new Adelphi graduate student beginning in Fall 2026.
3. Students must enroll in **6–7 credits per semester** to receive the PhD in Nursing Award, **ranging up to \$2,138 per semester** at the Garden City campus.
4. This award is applicable only to study at the **Garden City campus**.
5. The amount of your award is determined by your credit enrollment each semester as outlined above. This award, in combination with all other tuition-specific awards, **cannot exceed the cost of tuition and fees**.
6. Each admitted PhD student is reviewed holistically for consideration of a scholarship of **up to \$25,650 over the course of their studies**.
7. This award **may not be combined** with any other Adelphi University scholarships, grants, or tuition remission programs. If the amount of the Adelphi University PhD in Nursing Award exceeds other forms of institutional aid, this award will **replace any award of a lower amount**.
8. You must notify Adelphi's One-Stop Student Services Center of any additional scholarship or award you receive. Your award may be adjusted to ensure compliance with all institutional, federal, and state regulations, and to ensure total aid does not exceed tuition and fee costs.
9. Students are encouraged to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) as soon as possible. Recipients who have filed the FAFSA® and are eligible for federal financial aid will also receive a College Financing Plan stating the amount of the award.
10. Adelphi University reserves the right to revoke or adjust this award based on academic or behavioral violations, changes in enrollment, or eligibility for other federal, state, or institutional aid.
