

1. To be eligible for Adelphi University's Summer Welcome Award for Summer 2026, you must:
 - a. Register for one or more courses during the Summer 2026 sessions.
 - b. Enroll in full-time undergraduate study at Adelphi University with an anticipated initial entry term of Fall 2026. Both new incoming first-year students and new incoming undergraduate transfer students are eligible.
2. The amount of this award is fixed and is a one-time, non-renewable disbursement of \$2,000.
3. **This award will appear as a credit on your Fall 2026 semester bill after the last day to drop a course, as noted on the Adelphi University [academic calendar](#).**
4. Failure to enroll at Adelphi University in the Fall 2026 semester will result in the forfeiture of this award. Additionally, registering for and subsequently dropping your summer session course(s) during the University's designated add/drop period will render you ineligible for this award.
5. The total of your scholarships from all sources cannot exceed the tuition and fees at Adelphi University.
6. You must notify Adelphi's One-Stop Student Services Center of any additional scholarship awards you receive for the Summer 2026. Please note, these awards may be adjusted to ensure compliance with all institutional, federal and state regulations. This includes but is not limited to factors like Veterans educational benefits, external awards, and federal and state scholarships and grants.
7. Undergraduate scholarships, awards, and grants are typically awarded for full-time enrollment. However, the University may waive the full-time enrollment requirement in cases of qualifying disabilities, as determined by the Student Access Office. For details on this waiver and prorated scholarships, please reach out to the One-Stop Student Services Center.
8. Students enrolled in contractual partnership programs with discounted tuition do not qualify for this award.
9. If you're a **U.S. citizen or permanent resident** with a scholarship, it's advised to annually file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with the U.S. Department of Education, even if you don't expect financial assistance. After filing, Adelphi's One-Stop Student Services Center will provide a College Financing Plan (CFP) outlining your costs. Your award may be adjusted based on eligibility for federal, state, and institutional aid.
10. Please note that exclusions apply. The following courses and student populations are not eligible for this scholarship:
 - a. The Podium Education Global Accelerator Program course (0137-228)
 - b. Students enrolled in the Accelerated Nursing (ABSN) program
 - c. Students enrolled in the accelerated undergraduate program in Business
 - d. Incoming first-year students enrolled in the Summer Pre-College Program or the Bridges Summer Launch Program
 - e. Adelphi University International (AUI) students
 - f. Students eligible for tuition remission.
