

Request to Study At Another Institution

An undergraduate matriculated at Adelphi University may receive credit toward the baccalaureate by successfully completing a limited number of courses from another accredited institution. To receive permission to do so, the student must provide the following information and any other requested information prior to enrolling at the other institution.

If you have 64 credits, or more, you cannot take any courses at a 2 year college. Your final 30 credits must be taken at Adelphi. Learning Goals cannot be met by transfer credits. Requests to take a course concurrently with Adelphi courses must be in the form of an Academic Petition through the Dean's office. The number of credits awarded by the Visiting School will be the number of credits Adelphi will award. Note: Grades transferred in are not included in Adelphi's GPA. In order to receive credit, student must receive a grade of C- or better.
