Keynote Speaker



Jayati Ghosh

Development economist Jayati Ghosh is an award-winning author and professor of economics at the University of Massachusetts Amherst. Dr. Ghosh was appointed to the WHO Council on the Economics of Health for All in 2021, and in 2022 to the UN Secretary General's High-Level Advisory Board on Effective Multilateralism, mandated to provide a vision for international cooperation to deal with current and future challenges.

Dr. Ghosh previously taught economics at Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi for nearly 35 years, and her core areas of research include Asian political economy, economics and the developing world, and gender and care work. She has authored and/or edited 20 books and more than 200 scholarly articles. Her recent books, *The Making of a Catastrophe: Covid-19 and the Indian Economy*, and *When Governments Fail: Covid-19 and the Economy*, share her insights on the timely issue of how healthcare and the economy are intertwined, while *Earth for All: A Survival Guide for Humanity* shares her work as part of a leading global group of scientists and economists who present five extraordinary turnarounds of our economic picture to achieve prosperity for all in a single generation.

Dr. Ghosh has received several prizes, including the 2015 Adiseshiah Award for distinguished contributions to the social sciences in India; the International Labour Organisation's Decent Work Research Prize for 2011; and the NordSud Prize for Social Sciences 2010, Italy.

Dr. Ghosh has advised governments in India and other countries, including as Chairperson of the Andhra Pradesh Commission on Farmers' Welfare in 2004, and Member of the National Knowledge Commission of India (2005-09). She was the Executive Secretary of International Development Economics Associates (www.networkideas.org), an international network of heterodox development economists, from 2002 to 2021. In 2023, she was awarded the John Kenneth Galbraith award by the Agricultural and Applied Economics Association, "in recognition of breakthrough discoveries in economics and outstanding contributions to humanity through leadership, research and service."

Conference Notes

Presentation Themes

The presentations are organized by themes, to facilitate interdisciplinary exposure and to encourage students to "think outside the box". Presenting participants of this conference were grouped into sessions based on five general themes that best represent their work regardless of discipline or departmental affiliation. These general themes are: (1) Diversity, Ethics, and Social Justice, (2) Environmental and Global Challenges, (3) Health and Wellness, (4) Innovation and Technology, (5) Behavior and Social Systems. Through this arrangement, we hope to organize interdisciplinary sessions that bring scholars from different fields together.

ePoster and Oral Presentations

The ePoster and oral presentations have been organized by each submission's theme. Each session of the ePoster and oral presentations has diverse speakers from different disciplines. There are 4 concurrent sessions of ePoster and oral presentations. All ePoster sessions will be held in Ballrooms 201/202, with each session lasting for 55 minutes. For oral presentations, 6 rooms (Rooms 211-216) have been assigned to host 3 presenters in each room during each session. Each oral presenter will be given 10 minutes to present, along with a 5-minute Q&A session at the end of their presentation.

Dance, Music, and Visual Arts Presentations

This year's Dance, Music, and Visual Arts presentations will be taking place in Ballroom 203. Attendees can expect creative works exploring the intersections between live dance and music performances, as well as film choreography, painting, documentary, and innovative ways to support learning in Mathematics and Physics. For Dance and Music performances, students will present a portion of their work for up to 10 minutes, followed by a 5-minute Q&A discussion of their creative process. Visual Arts exhibitions will be showcased in the format of films and slide presentations, followed by Q&A facilitated by a faculty moderator.

Computer Science and Game Development Exhibitions

Computer Science and Game Development exhibitions will be held in Room 210. Presenters at this exhibition will showcase their latest projects via live demonstrations. Therefore, attendees will have the opportunity to personally experience the latest games, software applications, and computer technology that students at Adelphi University are developing alongside the faculty. There are 4 sessions throughout the conference, each lasting for 55 minutes.
