Financial Aid:

- The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is available starting October 1st 2016 for the 2017-2018 academic year on www.FAFSA.GOV. You may also be asked to complete a 2016-2017 application. Priority filing dates can be found on our website www.financial-aid.adelphi.edu.
- Our FAFSA Adelphi school code is 002666.

- Graduate students are only eligible for Federal Unsubsidized Direct Loans (5.31% interest rate).
- You must maintain a minimum of six (6) credits per semester in order to maintain eligibility for Federal Direct Loans.
- Financial Aid does not directly cover the summer semester (if coursework is required). If you do have to take summer sessions, you are suggested to reach out to the Office of Student Services or Student Financial Services for information about summer financial aid.

Scholarships:

- All academic merit-based scholarships are awarded through the Office of Admissions upon acceptance to the University. If you meet the criteria for a University scholarship, an award letter will be provided to you. You may also speak with the respective academic departments for scholarship information.

Refunds are calculated according to the refund schedule printed below as of the date the drop is received.
