Using the Internet as a Job Search Tool

Advantages of using the Internet for your job search:

- To research a company before you apply or interview.
- You can summarize the main points of the organization's "mission statement."
- Every day, more employers use scanning software to screen candidates and preview resumes.
- Internet research is another skill you can add to your resume, making you more marketable.

How to research a company:

Many recruiters say that candidates do not know enough about their company or position. Employers expect a serious candidate to have read through their site, to know the company 'mission' and to be prepared to discuss recent developments at the company during an interview.
