

VISITOR GUIDELINES

PLANNING FOR YOUR VISIT

We require all visitors to register in advance of arriving on campus. Prospective students are permitted to bring up to three guests. To register for a campus visit, including a one-on-one campus tour or self-guided tour, go to adelphi.edu/visit.

OUT-OF-STATE VISITORS OR RECENTLY TRAVELLED

Please carefully read the guidelines set forth by New York State and Adelphi University on the following page.

PREPARING FOR YOUR VISIT

You and your guests are required to bring a face covering to wear when visiting campus. Acceptable face coverings for COVID-19 include but are not limited to cloth-based face coverings and disposable masks that cover both the mouth and nose. Gaiter masks are not permitted. Face coverings should be worn at all times, including throughout the indoor and outdoor portions of your tour.

Our public restrooms will be available for use. We strongly encourage abiding by public health guidelines, including washing your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, and using hand sanitizer.

Refillable water stations are available throughout campus, and some dining locations have beverages

available for purchase. Otherwise, please plan to bring your own beverage containers.

ON THE DAY OF YOUR VISIT

CAMPUS ACCESS AND PARKING

You will be sent a mandatory self-check form for you and all guests in your party to complete on the day of your arrival. You must present this to Public Safety as you enter a building, as well as during check-in. We ask that you refrain from visiting campus if you do not feel well or have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

CHECK-IN PROCESS

Please check in at the University Admissions Office in the Nexus Building, no more than 10 minutes prior to your visit time. A campus map will be included in your confirmation and reminder emails.

Tour groups will be limited to one party per guide, and self-guided tours will be limited per time slot. For the safety of our campus community, residence halls will not be shown on the tour and we are limiting the number of buildings that tour groups will enter.

COUNSELOR APPOINTMENTS

If you are on campus and would like to speak with an admissions counselor, meetings may be conducted in our lobby or in a large conference room, depending on availability. We strongly encourage registering for a virtual appointment by contacting your personal enrollment counselor or giving our office a call at **516.877.3050**.

While Adelphi University is taking all precautions to protect our community, we cannot eliminate the risk of COVID-19 exposure and infection on campus. Please be reminded that you are undertaking your visit at your own risk. If any visitor shows symptoms and tests positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of visiting campus, please report that information to healthandwellness@adelphi.edu or 516.877.6000.

CONTINUED GUIDELINES FOR

OUT-OF-STATE VISITORS OR THOSE WHO RECENTLY TRAVELLED

NYS travel advisories and Adelphi University require the following steps for out-of-state* visitors, or visitors who have recently travelled:

VACCINATED TRAVELERS:

• Travelers who have been vaccinated (longer than 14 days with both doses but not to exceed 90 days) do not need to take a rapid test. Please submit vaccination records to healthandwellness@adelphi.edu. Upon submission, you will receive a confirmation email stating that you have completed the necessary state requirements required for your visit.

NON-VACCINATED TRAVELERS:

- Travelers who have not been vaccinated must obtain a COVID test within 72 hours of your visit.
- You will be required to send test results to healthandwellness@adelphi.edu prior to your visit. Upon submission, you will receive a confirmation email stating that you have completed the necessary state requirements required for your visit.

- *The contiguous states of Connecticut, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Vermont are exempt from this quarantine and testing rule.
